#### Social Neuroscience for UDP Psychology and Medicine students

#### What is this opportunity about?

This Social Neuroscience COIL course is a unique hybrid collaborative learning experience between Universidad Diego Portales (UDP) and Indiana University Bloomington (IUB) that will be held the second semester of 2024, open now for enrolment for students of Psychology and Medicine at UDP.

You will be able to join around 30 international students from Indiana University Bloomington, in a COIL (*Collaborative Online International Learning*) format in the context of classes led by Dr. Alejandra Rossi from UDP and Dr. Aina Puce from IUB.

Over the semester, students will explore topics such as non-verbal communication, prosocial behavior, emotional contagion, and Theory of Mind. Key activities include synchronous and asynchronous discussions, including lectures, student-led debates, and group discussions on scientific articles. This course aims to provide a comprehensive understanding of social neuroscience, enhance intercultural competence and offer formal academic credits upon completion.

#### What can this course offer me?

- The COIL course will allow you to obtain a certificate of participation in this Virtual Exchange Program that will add up to your international academic experience on your CV.
- According to internal regulations at each faculty, this course will be recognised with academic credits.
- You'll have access to a diverse and constructive learning environment led by two outstanding experts in the field of neuroscience and be able to interact with students from the US during a whole semester!

There are *15 spots* available for UDP students from the schools of Psychology and Medicine, a unique opportunity to internationalize your academic career without leaving UDP campus!

- Be a UDP student of either Psychology or Medicine
- For Psychology students you must have passed the course 'Neurociencias y Psicología'.
- Students from the School of Medicine can apply from 1st year onwards, as long as they have the required level of English for interactions with their counterparts in the US.
- Ideally a B1 English level, focus on conversational English and **no certification** required.
- Good academic qualifications and a lot of motivation regarding the topics of the program!
